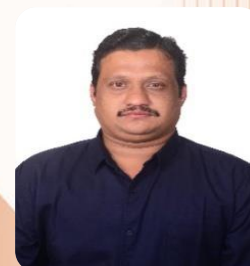

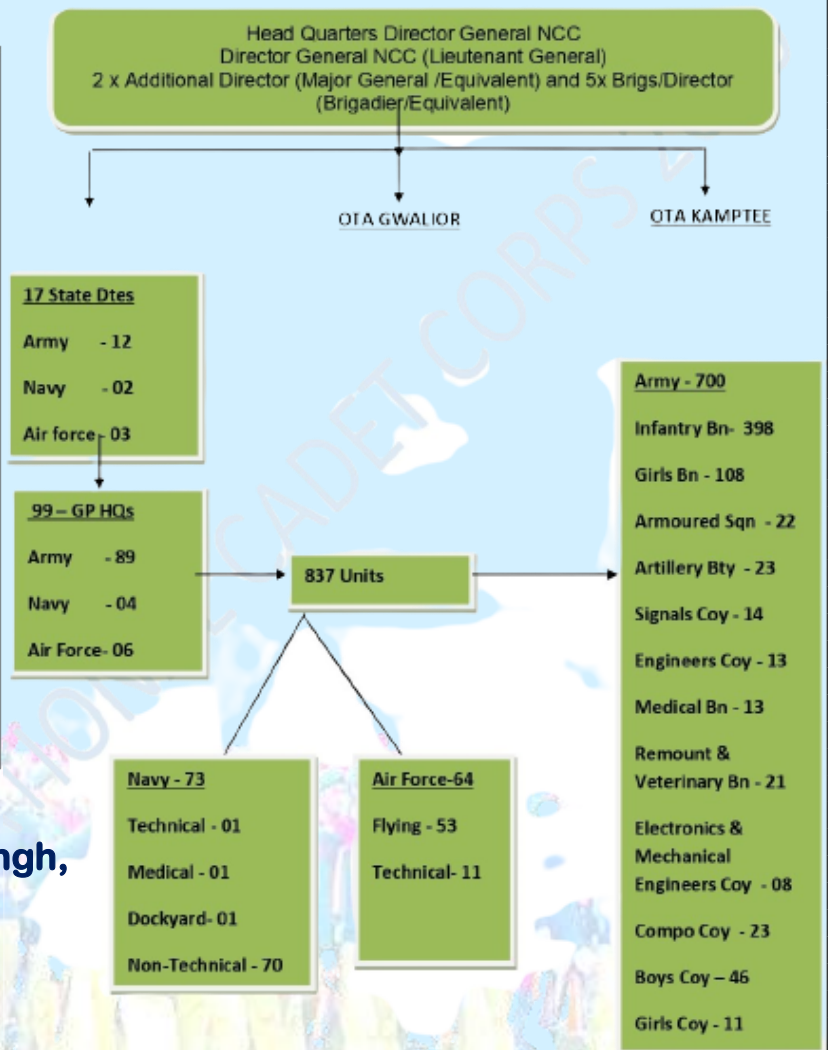

Organization Structure of NCC

The NCC is headed by the Director General (DG), an officer of three-star rank. The DG is assisted by two additional director generals (A and B) of two-star rank (major-general, rear-admiral or air vice-marshal).

The National Cadet Corps is the largest uniformed youth organisation, with its Headquarters at New Delhi, India. It is open to students on voluntary basis. NCC is a tri-services organization, which includes the Army, Navy and Air Wing, engaged in grooming the youth of the country into disciplined and patriotic citizens.

THE NCC

The '**University Corps**', which was created under the Indian Defence Act 1917, with the objective to make up for the shortage in the Army. In 1920, when the Indian Territorial Act was passed, the '**University Corps**' was replaced by the **University Training Corps (UTC)**. The aim was to raise the status of the UTC and make it more attractive to the youth. The UTC Officers and cadets dressed like the army. It was a significant step towards the Indianization of armed forces. It was rechristened as UOTC so the National Cadet Corps can be considered as a successor of the **University Officers Training Corps (UOTC)** which was established by British Government in 1942. During World War II, the UOTC never came up to the expectations set by the British. This led to the idea that some better schemes should be formed, which could train more young men in a better way, even during peace. A committee headed by **H N Kunzru** recommended a cadet organisation to be established in schools and colleges at a national level. The **National Cadet Corps Act** was accepted by the Governor General and on **15 July 1948** the **National Cadet Corps** came into existence.

In 1948, the Girls Division was raised in order to give equal opportunities to girls who are studying in school and college. The NCC was given an inter-service image in **1950** when the **Air Wing** was added, followed by the **Naval Wing in 1952**. In the same year, the NCC curriculum was extended to include community development/social service activities as a part of the NCC syllabus at the behest of Late Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru who took keen interest in the growth of the NCC. Following the 1962 Sino-Indian War, to meet the requirement of the Nation, the NCC training was made compulsory in 1963. In 1968, the Corps was again made voluntary. During Indo-Pakistani war of 1965 & Bangladesh-Pakistani war of 1971, NCC cadets were the second line of defence. They organised camps to assist ordnance factories, supplying arms and ammunition to the front and also were used as patrol parties to capture enemy paratroopers.

AIM OF NCC

- To develop qualities of character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, sportsmanship and ideal of selfless services among the youth to make them responsible citizens.
- To create human resources organised, trained and motivated youth, to provide leadership in all walks of life and be always available for the service of the nation.

UNITS: These 17 directorates are divided in **96 Group Headquarters**, in total of 814 units divided in three service groups. Out of **684 Army** wing units (including technical and girls' unit), **69 Naval** wing units and **61 Air Squadrons**. There are two training establishments namely officers Training Academy, **Kamptee (Nagpur, Maharashtra)** and **Women Officers Training Academy, Gwalior**.

NCC FLAG



The NCC flag for various units of the NCC was first introduced in 1951. The flag was of same pattern, colour and size as was used by various regiments of the Army. The only difference was that it had the NCC badge and unit designation placed in the centre. Later on, it was felt that the flag should be in keeping with the inter-service character of the Corps. In 1954 the existing tricolour flag was introduced. The three colours in the flag depict the three services of the Corps, red for the Army, deep blue for the Navy and light blue for the Air Force. The letters NCC and the NCC crest in gold in the middle of the flag encircled by a wreath of lotus, give the flag a colourful look and a distinct identity.

The flag indicates the following:

1. Red colour-Army
2. Dark blue-Navy
3. Sky blue-Air force
4. "NCC" -two training institutes (OTA Gwalior and Kamptee)
5. 17 Golden petals- 17 directorates.
6. The wording written in Hindi represents its motto, "Unity and Discipline".

TAKEAWAYS OF BEING AN NCC CADET

1. NCC is a highly reputed body which is also a second line of defence. In India, many youngsters are trained in line with defence in case the need arises. If young students want to make it their career option, then being a NCC cadet holds a lot of weight. As they are directly associated with the ministry of defence.
2. NCC helps cadets to improve their overall personality by teaching them leadership qualities, discipline, honesty, working in a team, time management, to have high self-confidence, being physically fit, service before self, social service, and responsibility of service towards motherland and to be a responsible citizen of India.
3. Since NCC camps are held all over India therefore there is training in a various part of the country, hence students get an opportunity of visit new places and learn the art of independence. They are required to use their social skills and their senses to get to know new places and adapt to the varying environment. Other than just social skills they also get to learn about the history and art of the new place.
4. Under the regime of exchange programme, there are a few selected students who get an opportunity to visit other countries and learn various things which are practiced in other nations and exchange experiences with cadets who happen to come to India from foreign lands
5. NCC has both Theory and Practical sessions taught in parades conducted regularly in college and various camps.
6. In practical session, NCC cadets will learn weapon training (assemble and disassemble of rifle, firing in short range), Map reading, tent pitching, drill, weapon drill and adventurous activities (mountaineering, rock climbing, paragliding, trekking, scuba diving, etc) in special camps.
7. In theory sessions, NCC cadets will learn about NCC and Defence forces, communication techniques used in military, health and hygiene, history of great warriors of India, field craft, battle craft, current affairs and General knowledge.

NCC ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND CERTIFICATE EXAM

Eligibility criteria:

1. Must be a citizen of India.
2. Age limit for senior division -for both boys and girls is 19-25.
3. One should be physically fit.

CERTIFICATE EXAM:

A cadet must have attended a minimum of 75% of the total training parade and must have attended minimum one camp in order to take up any certificate exam in NCC. Certificates will be awarded only if NCC cadets clear both practical and theory exam. There are three different certificate exams; 'C' certificate has the highest value.

1. **'A' certificate:** It is awarded to junior (school) cadets on completion of second year of training.
2. **'B' certificate:** This is awarded to senior (PU/Degree) cadets on completion of second year of training.
3. **'C' certificate:** This is awarded to senior (Degree) cadets on completion of third year of training. B certificate is a prerequisite.

BENEFITS OF NCC CERTIFICATE

1. NCC cadets have a special quota to join the armed forces.
2. Under the regime of exchange programme, the selected students will get an opportunity to visit other countries and learn various things which are practiced in other nations and exchange experiences with cadets who happen to come to India from foreign lands.
3. Several central and state Government organisations who give special preference to NCC cadets.
4. NCC is a highly reputed body which is also a third line of defense. Being a NCC Cadet adds an advantage over other students at the time of defense recruitment.
5. During 3 years of NCC Journey cadets learn several other valuable things such as selflessness, honesty, discipline, hard work and ways to build confidence and gain leadership qualities.
6. Since NCC camps are held all over India, students get an opportunity to visit new places and learn the art of independence.
7. It builds a sense of patriotism among NCC cadets, which leads to providing there optimum services when the country is in need.
8. Apart from the military activities, the cadets are taught other skills such as parachuting, paragliding and basic aviation courses.
9. Under Youth exchange programme, students get an opportunity to visit other countries, learn practices followed and experiences in other countries.
10. Reservation for NCC "C" Certificate holder in Central/Sate govt recruitments.
11. Opportunities to join for SSB, CRF and BSF etc.,
12. Reservations in Higher education like Post Graduations.
13. Opportunities to join the Indian Army as Agneveera.

Mrityunjaya Vidya Peetha, an educational institution with spiritual blessings, is located at Haunsbhavi, a tiny village which is a part of Hirekerur (Tq) in Haveri (Dist.) of Karnataka state. The place where the Vidya Peetha stands today was the "Karma Bhoomi" of his Holiness Sri Mrityunjaya Swamiji of Murugamatha, Dharwad. Camps

Camps are important part of NCC, they are playing very vital role in cadets' life. The aim of Camps is to impart collective training to the cadets with special emphasis on the development of qualities of leadership. Special emphasis is laid on Development of Team Spirit and Leadership Qualities and comprehensive training in Drill, Weapon Training, Hygiene and Sanitation, Social Service etc. It is imperative that all camps be planned in consultation with all agencies including Educational Institutions, District Administration and the Director of Public Instruction / Education well before the commencement of the year and all concerned be intimated of date and location well in advance.

Types of Camps:

(a) Annual Training Camps/Combined Annual Training Camps (ATCs/ CATCs):

These camps are conducted for SD, SW, JD and JW cadets over a period of 8/10 days. The aim of these camps is to introduce cadets to a regimented way of life. During Camp training endeavor should be made to give cadets maximum exposure to Range Drill, Firing and Specialized training with emphasis on community living, discipline, character, confidence building and First Aid.

(b) Centrally Organised Camps (COC):

These are planned at the HQ DGNCC level and are of 12 days duration. The Aim of these camps is to bring together all cadets from various parts of the country and to enable them to live and know the culture of different states, which help them in imbibing 'Esprit De Corps' as well as Unity in Diversity against a backdrop of national Integration. The various types of COCs are:

(i) Leadership Camps: These camps are organized on an all-India basis to develop leadership qualities in cadets and also provide SSB training to all wing cadets for induction into Armed Forces.

(ii) Thal Sainik Camp: The aim of this camp is to give an exposure to salient aspects of Army Wing training and generate healthy competitive spirit by conducting Army Wing competitions contributing towards Prime Minister's Banner awarded during Republic Day Parade. It is conducted at Delhi in DGNCC Camp.

(iii) Nau Sainik Camp: The aim of this camp is to give an exposure to salient aspects of Naval Wing training and generate healthy competitive spirit by conducting Naval Wing competitions contributing towards Prime Minister's Banner awarded during Republic Day Parade. It is conducted at Karwar/Visakhapatnam.

(iv) Vayu Sainik Camp: The aim of this camp is to give an exposure to salient aspects of Air Wing training and generate healthy competitive spirit by conducting Air Wing competitions contributing towards Prime Minister's Banner awarded during Republic Day Parade. It is conducted at Jodhpur in Rajasthan.

(v) Republic Day Camp (RDC): NCC Republic Day camp is the culmination of all NCC Training activities and is held at **Garrison Parade Grounds**, Delhi Cantonment from 01 Jan to 29 Jan each year. Selected NCC cadets from all the states and Union Territories attend the camp as per vacancies allotted by HQ DGNCC annually. The camp is inaugurated by the Hon'ble Vice President of India and culminates with the Prime Minister's Rally on 28 January. During the camp, visit of Hon'ble Raksha Mantri, Hon'ble Raksha Rajya Mantri, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Delhi and three service chiefs are also organized. During the RDC, various competitions are conducted amongst the 17 NCC Directorates to decide the Champion Directorate for award of Prime Minister's Banner. Competitions are keenly contested in various events such as Drill, Guard of Honour, Rajpath

Contingent and Prime Minister's Rally, National Integration Awareness, Line & Flag Area, Cultural, Best Cadet in each wing, i.e., Army, Navy and Air Force, Aero modelling, Ship modelling competitions are also conducted.

(vi) Ek Bharat Shresth Bharat Camp: National Integration camps are conducted on all India basis with representation from each region and help to integrate the diversity amongst various states of India. In addition, Special National Integration Camps are held at remote and border areas to give an exposure to the difficulties faced by the citizens residing in these areas. The duration of the camp is 12 days for SD/SW and JD/JW.

(vii) SSB Screening Camp: SSB Screening Camps for both SD boys and SW girls are conducted at Officers Training Academies and other Centrally Organised camps. The aim is to orient and prepare cadets for selection for induction into Armed Forces.

(viii) Rock Climbing Camp: Rock Climbing camps are held to expose the cadets to the basics of elementary rock climbing and to inculcate spirit of adventure, leadership qualities, team spirit, camaraderie as also physical fitness to include enhancing of stamina and endurance amongst the cadets.

(ix) All India Treks: These camps are conducted under the aegis of DGNCC. These treks are conducted by designated State Directorates. These camps make the cadets aware of the uniqueness and rich cultural diversity of India. The duration of these camps is of 10 days. The aim of trekking camps is to develop spirit of adventure, leadership, stamina, endurance, self-confidence, team spirit as well as esprit-de-corps' and also to imbibe environmental awareness and concern, inculcate respect for local customs, culture and history and lastly to promote national integration'.

(c) Military Attachment Camp:

These Camps are of 12 days duration and are for Senior Division boys and Senior Wing Girls. Aim of these camps is to expose selected Senior Division Cadets to Armed Forces environment to give a feel of Military Training which would give them confidence and inspire them to join the Armed Forces. Selected girl cadets are exposed to day-to-day functioning of a Military Hospitals, which would give an exposure in the field of Hygiene, Sanitation and patient management. Attachment training is also given to SW and SD cadets at OTA and IMA, Air Force and Navy academies.

(d) Attachment Training IMA/OTA:

These camps are conducted for a duration of 12 days for SD/SW cadets. Detailed training schedule is prepared in with IMA/OTA. The aim of these training is 'to expose the cadets to the training imparted at IMA/OTA and to motivate them to join the Armed Forces as Commissioned Officers'.

About Mahadevappa Mailara

Mahadevappa Mailara better known as 'Karnataka's Bhagat Singh' was born on June 8, 1911 in Motebennur village of Byadgi taluk, Haveri District. His father was Marthandappa and mother Basamma. His mother was a great patriot who too had been imprisoned for the cause of Independence. He studied in **Mrityunjaya Vidya Peetha Haunsbhavi** of



Haveri district. At the age of 16, he married **Siddamma** and despite of his bounding's to family affairs he was not distracted from his passion to work for the freedom of the country. He had a deep desire to visit Sabarmati Ashram and to get involved in its activities. Meanwhile, Gandhiji sent a message to the Indian youth organization in Dharwad to send one or two representatives to **Sabarmati Ashram** from Karnataka. The youth association sent young Mahadev to Sabarmati Ashram. Gandhiji was highly impressed by Mahadevappa noticing his justice, non-violence, patriotism, purity, self-control, conviction, boldness, humbleness, unity, physical work, equality, peace and sacrifice.

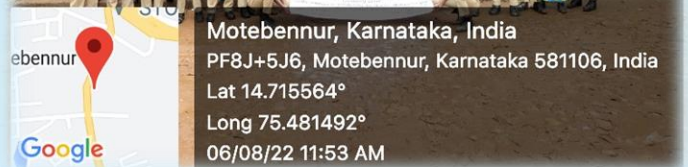
On 12th March 1930 Mahatma Gandhiji along with his 78 freedom fighters began his march from Sabarmati to Dandi. Along with Gandhiji, Mahadevappa was also arrested and jailed. **From Karnataka Mahadevappa was the only person to take part in Salt Satyagraha**

and his wife Siddamma was the only woman to take part in the Civil Disobedience Movement During the Quit India Movement. Gandhiji gave the call 'Do or Die', Mahadevappa lead the movement of south division of Dharwad.

Mahadevappa Mailara participated in non-cooperation movement call given by Mahatma Gandhiji and he was killed by British police on 1st April 1943, along with his followers Tirakappa Madiwalar and Veerabasayya Hiremath while breaking open the treasury where British officers had kept land Revenue in Hosaritti Village. Veerabhadra Swamy Temple by collecting forcefully from farmers. Mahadevappa Mailar used to collect back Land Revenue and redistributed it concerned farmers. He was a great patriot and freedom fighter. He sacrificed his life for the service of the society and liberation of country. After independence a magnificent building Veera Soudha was built on his Samadhi.

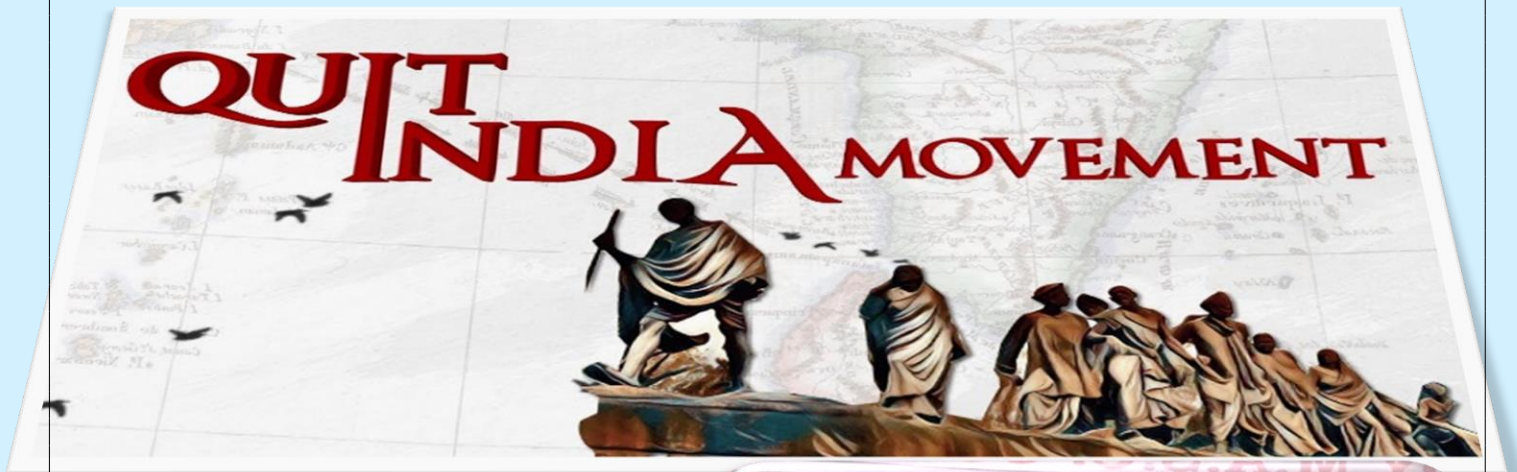

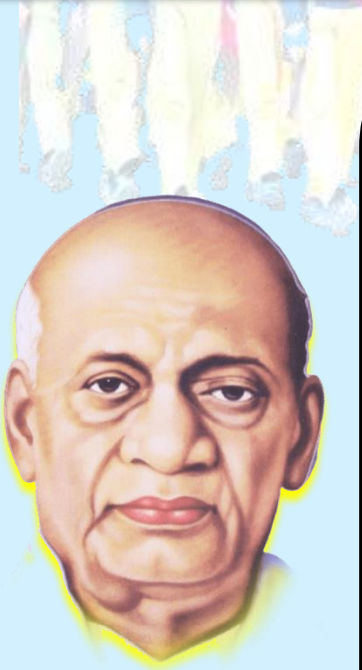


National Unity Day

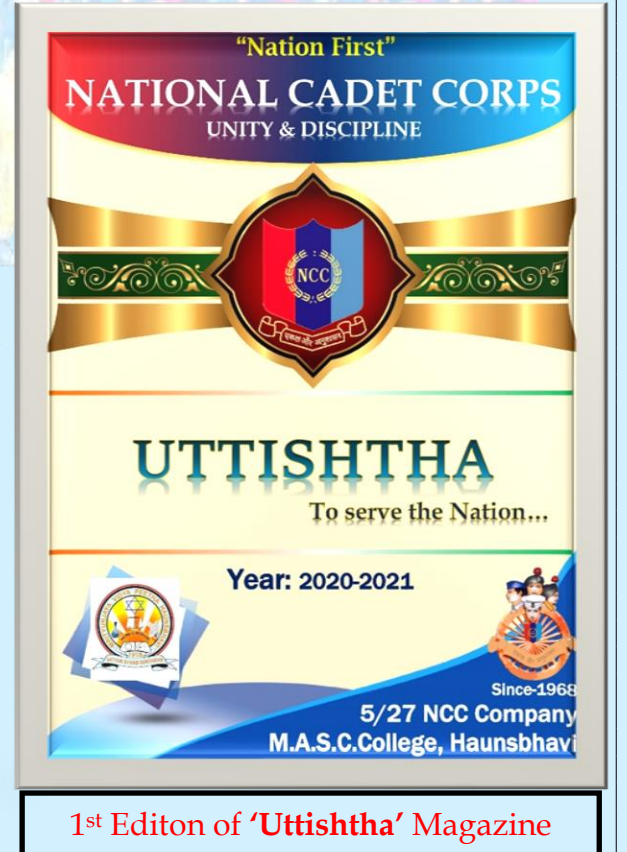

RULES AND REGULATION OF NCC ALUMNI ASSOCIATION (NCCAA)

SHORT TITLE

1. The Rules and Regulations may be called „Rules and Regulations of NCC Alumni Association“.

DEFINITION

2. In these Rules and Regulations unless the context otherwise requires:-

"Governing Council" means the Governing Council of NCCAA.

"Executive Committee" means the Executive Committee of NCCAA.

"President" means the President of Governing Council of NCCAA

"Chairman" means the Chairman of Executive Committee of NCCAA.

"Secretary" means the Secretary of NCCAA

"Treasurer" means the Treasurer of NCCAA

REGISTERED OFFICE

3. **Registered Office.** The registered office of the association will be at New Delhi and its correspondence address will be HQ DG NCC, West Block 4, RK Puram, New Delhi - 110066.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

4. The aim and objectives of the NCC AA shall be as under:-

An Association whose primary aim is to bring NCC alumni together for furtherance of aims of NCC and assist in Nation building.

To foster and strengthen the affinity between the alumni of the NCC, India.

To execute programmes in consonance with the above object and undertake such activities and through such means that promotes the object of enhancement of standards.

To get valuable advice and assist NCC in maintaining a very high standard of training and sports.

To maintain and update the database of registered Alumni with NCCAA.

To utilise experience of registered Alumni for benefit and progress of enrolled NCC cadets.

To provide guidance by registered Alumni of NCCAA to enrolled NCC cadets in their endeavor for better opportunities in future.

To promote skill development, impart employable skills through the registered Alumni of NCCAA working in the government, reputed industries in India and abroad.

To encourage and felicitate enrolled NCC cadets excelling in fields of academics or sports.

To involve registered Alumni of NCCAA in the overall development of NCC and the society

MEMBERSHIP

5. There shall be the following classes of members vis-a-vis their eligibility, namely :-

Life Members. All ex-cadets of NCC other than those expelled on disciplinary grounds, are eligible to become life members by paying membership fee. The ex-cadets will need to register themselves on Alumni form on NCC website (indiancc.nic.in) to become the members of NCCAA.

Associate Members. All Officers (incl WTOs & WTLOs) and PI Staff posted in NCC HQs/Units, who have served for at least one year are eligible to apply for Associate Membership. All Associate NCC Officers who have served for at least five years in NCC are eligible to apply for Associate Membership. Such applications may be considered for grant of Associate Membership by the Executive Committee.

Honorary Members. The Executive Committee may, at its discretion, confer Honorary Membership upon dignitaries and persons of excellence visiting NCC and to others who have assisted NCCAA or the NCC in a manner deserving such a recognition.

Membership Fees. A onetime fee of Rs 100/- (Rs One Hundred Only) will be charged for obtaining membership in NCCAA. The fee may be paid by online / offline mode. A membership card containing membership number will be provided once the membership is approved.

Rights of Members. Members are eligible to attend functions and participate in various activities organised by NCCAA as per sole discretion of the NCCAA in this regard.

Felicitation of Alumni. Any alumni who has performed exceptionally well at National or International level in any field bringing name to the National Cadet Corps, or such other alumni who has distinguished himself/herself in a significant manner, as decided by Executive Committee, will be felicitated by the NCCAA. The short listing of name of alumni to be felicitated will be the domain of NCCAA Executive Committee.

Cessation of Members. A member shall cease/ stand disqualified to be a member :-

If a member, in the opinion of the Executive Committee, is found acting in a manner that brings disrepute to or is prejudicial to the interests of NCCAA/NCC. Such cases will be duly analyzed looking at facts & figures and the decision of Executive Committee will be communicated in writing and binding on the member.

By giving notice in writing of his intention to resign to the Secretary and acceptance by the Executive committee.

Restoration of Membership. A member whose name has been removed from the list of members may on appeal have his name restored to the list, if the Executive Committee is of the opinion that for good and sufficient reasons his name ought to be restored thereto. The reasons for restoration to be recorded in writing through the minutes of the conference in which the decision was taken.

Database of the Members. A database shall be maintained indicating details of alumni including their addresses, occupations etc. and a full list shall be made available on the website as per consent given by registered member.

GOVERNING BODY

NCCAA Governing Council. The task of policy decisions shall be vested in the Governing Council which shall be empowered to take policy decisions and frame rules and act as an oversight body on the Executive Committee.

The Governing Council shall comprises of the following members

NCCAA Executive Committee. The management of business of NCCAA shall be vested in Executive Committee and shall be empowered to regulate financial limits, fees and charges etc with the ratification of Governing Council and take decisions on day-to-day functioning of NCC AA. The Executive Committee shall comprise of the following members:-

NCCAA may hire staff for its requirement duly following the selection as laid down in the SoP which will be approved by the Executive Committee and updated from time to time. The payment of such staff will be from NCCAA funds.

NCCAA State Directorate Chapter Working Committee. Each of the State Directorate of NCC will have its respective Chapter and shall be called as “NCC Alumni Association – (Name of State Directorate) Chapter” for example “NCC Alumni Association – Andhra Pradesh and Telangana Directorate Chapter”. Each State Directorate Chapter will have a working committee for routine functioning and shall comprise of the following members:-

Nomination of Alumni in the Governing Council, Executive Committee and State Directorate Working Committee will be done through a SOP created for this process duly approved by the Governing Council taking into account their achievements/contribution to the society and nation during both NCC period and post NCC period. There will be analogy in selection process of Alumni at both Central and State level. They will be nominated after due ratification by the Governing Council/Executive Committee.

The life members of NCCAA, who are eligible to be nominated in NCCAA Governing Council/ Executive Committee/ State Working Committee, may be invited to join the Governing Council/Executive Committee/State Working Committee, as co-opted members for a duration of two years, for assisting in furthering the aims and objects of NCCAA. Guidelines for selecting such members will be as under:-

- The nominated member should be an Indian citizen less than 58 yrs of age.

- The nominated member should be a life member of NCC Alumni Association.
- Minimum one of the nominated members may preferably be a lady.
- The nominated member should be amongst persons who have special knowledge or practical experience in respect of such matters as Armed Forces, CAPFs, Government Service, Science & Technology, Sports, Fine Arts, Social Service, Industries and Services sector.
- The term of nominated members will be two years non extendable.
- The names of persons to be invited to become nominated members, will be recommended (including reserves), by the Executive Committee after receiving their consent and thereafter put up for approval to the Governing Council. Once an individual gives his/her consent, he/she will be formally invited to join the Governing Council/ Executive Committee/ State Working Committee

Meeting / Decisions and Quorum. The Governing Council shall meet as often as possible but at least once every year. Secretary shall also by a requisition, by not less than half the strength to include one member from Ser (a) to (d) and one alumni of the Governing Council, convene meetings of the Governing Council as and when desired. Notice with agenda for consideration of all such meetings should be duly issued at least fourteen days in advance. Emergent meetings may be convened at short notice.

Terms of the Governing Council and Executive Committee. The terms of the Governing Council and Executive Committee shall be of permanent nature. However, a person relinquishing his appointment will cease to be member of Governing Council and Executive Committee Similarly the new incumbents of these appointments will automatically become the member of the Governing Council and Executive Committee. However, tenure of life members who will be invited to join Governing Council/Executive Committee/State Working Committee as co-opted members will be restricted to a max duration of two years.

Resignation of Members. A member of the Governing Council/Executive Committee/State Working Committee shall deem to have resigned if he fails to attend three consecutive meetings without prior notice of absence thereof, and / or intimates in writing of his intention to resign upon acceptance by the Governing Council/Executive Committee/ State Working Committee.

Powers of President. The President shall be the Head of NCCAA and shall preside over all meetings pertaining to policy decisions and framing rules of NCCAA. He shall have the power to give directions in writing with respect to the functioning of NCCAA.

Powers and Duties of the Chairman. The Chairman shall be the head of Executive Committee of NCCAA and shall preside over all meetings of the Executive Committee of NCCAA. He shall oversee all operations & functions of the Association and perform all the duties commonly incident to the Office of the Chairman including such other duties as the Governing Council shall assign. He shall have the power to give directions in writing to the Secretary and/or Treasurer of Executive Committee regarding the day-to-day functioning of NCCAA.

Powers and Duties of the Secretary. Secretary shall be responsible on behalf of the Executive Committee for:-

Maintaining accounts of all the Income and Expenditure of NCCAA.

Maintaining all books, files and records with regard to the above.

Making payments under appropriate authority.

Collecting money on behalf of NCCAA for the programmed event and issue receipts thereof.

Ensuring that all expenditures incurred are in accordance with the aims and objects of the NCCAA and are in accordance with the procedures contained in these articles.

Providing all necessary information to the Auditors.

Put up fund status to the Governing Council annually.

FINANCES

The corpus will be generated from the internal accruals of NCCAA. However, in future, if decision is taken to fund NCCAA through budgetary allocations, provisions of the Ministry of Finance (Department of Expenditure) O.M. No. 8 (4) E-Coord/84 dated 15.10.1984 or any future amendment from time to time will be made applicable to NCCAA. Also, provisions under Rule 229 (viii) of GFR 2017 and any instructions thereof will be suitably incorporated in the SoP.

Sources of Income. The source of funds of NCCAA include, but are not limited to as follows: -

- Membership fees from members of NCCAA.
- Grants, donation etc, received by NCCAA from registered members.
- Fees for attending Annual Event cum Reunion and other functions.
- Income from investments
- In a manner permitted by Law and approved by Governing Council.

Principle of Fund Management. Funds for NCCAA will be received only at the NCCAA Head Office at Delhi. A separate account will be opened accordingly and duly audited from time to time.

Limits of Incurring Expenditure. All expenses incurred out of NCCAA funds shall be strictly in accordance with the annual budget duly approved by the Governing Council for the furtherance of the aims and objective of NCCAA. Any unforeseen expenditure considered expedient, but not budgeted, shall be subjected to the following financial limits:-

- Treasurer may incur contingent expenses up to Rs 2500/- per transaction subject to an annual limit of Rs 50,000/-.
- Secretary may incur contingent expenses up to Rs 5000/- per transaction subject to an annual limit of Rs. 1,00,000/-.
- The Executive Committee may approve expenditure up to Rs 5,00,000/- per transaction subject to an annual limit of Rs 50,00,000/-.
- Any upward/downward revision in the above mentioned financial limits of Working Committee of State Directorate and Executive Committee will be made with the approval of the Governing Council.
- All expenses for cultural and other functions shall be as far as possible paid out of contributions from the participants and or revenue raised specially for the occasion.

Scope of Activities. The projects which can be undertaken through NCCAA for any activity approved/ratified by Governing Council in furtherance of its goals and objectives will inter alia include :-

- To promote and provide support to NCC cadets in sports and adventure activities, training activities, preparation of Competitive examinations, Skill development etc.
- To promote and support Social Service and Community Development activities like Water conservation schemes, Afforestation activities, Creation of environmental parks, Use of renewable sources of energy, Rain water harvesting projects, Cleanliness and sanitation drives etc.
- To encourage and support Women Empowerment schemes.
- Felicitation of a Distinguished Alumni.

- Any other work, with the approval/ratification of the Governing Council.

Modalities of Execution of Projects.

Financial Powers.

- A project with expenditure up to Rs 5 Lakh will be approved by Executive Committee.
- A project with expenditure above Rs 5 Lakh will be recommended by Executive Committee and will be forwarded to Governing Council for approval.

Procedure for Execution of Projects

- The procedure adopted for execution of projects will be based on guidelines as given in General Financial Rules (GFR 2017) and amendments thereof
- A project limited to purchase of equipment / items, both expendable and non-expendable, will be undertaken through GeM portal or Central Public Procurement Portal.
- A project, the execution of which involves complete solution including hiring of manpower , purchase of assets etc will be based on open tender and selection will be Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS).

Disposal of Income. The income and property of the NCCAA shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects set forth in the Memorandum of Association/ Rules and Regulations of the NCCAA, and no part thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly to the member of NCCAA.

BOOK OF ACCOUNTS, AUDIT AND FINANCIAL YEAR

Book of Account. The Executive Committee shall make such arrangements as necessary for the proper keeping of books and accounts of NCCAA. Accounts shall be kept of all sums of money received and expended by NCCAA, and of the assets, credits and liabilities of NCCAA.

Financial Year. The financial year of NCCAA shall be from first day of April until the last day of March following.

Operation of Bank Account. The account of NCCAA will be opened in a Nationalised Bank, operated jointly by the Secretary and Treasurer.

Accounting of NCCAA Funds

- The NCCAA funds will be utilised for projects as mentioned in Para 29 of the Rules and Regulations.
- A certificate will be furnished by the project executing agency and NCCAA Executive Committee that the project has been completed with the funds provided by NCCAA and no other agency.
- No amount will be transferred from NCCAA fund to any other fund (Public or Regimental), as loan or permanent transfer.

Audit of Accounts

Audit Committee. Internal audit of accounts shall be carried out by an Audit Committee with representative of MoD (Fin) as Chairman and consisting of two or more life members, once every six months, under arrangements made by the Secretary. The nomination of life members carrying out internal audit will be approved by Executive Committee. The life members carrying out internal audit, will not be repeated in a period of five years.

Once every year the accounts of NCCAA shall be examined and the correctness of the Income and Expenditure account and Balance Sheet ascertained by an Auditor or Auditors duly appointed by the Executive Committee for the purpose.

- Following criteria should be considered while selecting the auditor / audit firm :-

- The firm/auditor should be empaneled with the C&AG in the panel of audit firms eligible for major audits.
- The firm should be Independent of the NCCAA.
- A certificate upfront to be given by the firm specifying that no partner of the audit firm or any person directly/indirectly is related to any member of Governing Council/Executive Committee/ State Working Committee. Relative would mean husband, wife, brother, or sister or any lineal ascendant or descendant.
- The accounts of NCC AA along with the report of the auditors on approval of Governing Council shall be regularly published in the DGNCC Website in Alumni Column for the information of life members.

DISSOLUTION

If the association needs to be dissolved, it shall be dissolved as per the provisions laid down under sections 13 and 14 of the Societies Registration Act of 1860 as applicable to Delhi.

AMENDMENTS

Powers for making amendments in the aim and objectives of the association and Rules and Regulations of the association will be with that of the Governing Council and interpretation pertaining to rules of the association given by the Governing Council will be final and binding on all stake holders.

EVENTS

Events such as Reunion, Seminar, etc will be organised at both National and State level as per yearly calendar approved by the Governing Council which will be published on DG NCC website. These may be attended by registered members of NCCAA on payment of prescribed fees. The attendance to the event will be voluntary. The arrangement of accommodation and transport will have to be done by members/attendees themselves unless otherwise specified.

REGISTRATION

The NCC Alumni Association will be registered as per „The Societies Registration Act 1860“.

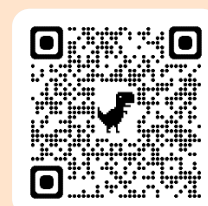
